Early Intervention

Students who worked with the ASC as part of an early intervention after failing their first assignment in their first course were more likely to persist 20 weeks later. [Learn more here.](#)

Statistics Course Grade

For students with lower GPAs, statistics coaching seems to have a greater positive impact on their first course final grade. [Learn more here.](#)

Persistence

Students who worked with an academic coach had greater odds of persisting 6 to 9 months later compared to a matched sample. [Learn more here.](#)
